

PRESENTATION ABOUT PLANNING AND MISSION:

I plan for further development of the Computer Engineering Department and its smooth running under my chairmanship. He commended the efforts and dedication of Dr. Abdulaziz S. Almulhem, former chairman of the department, and Dr. Jarallah S. AlGhamdi, who carried out the COE Departmental Activities very smoothly during the last semester (051), in addition to his current assignments as Dean, CCSE.

I want to share some ideas and views with them about the vision and mission of the department.

Mission of the department:

Regarding the mission of the department, I urge all of you to exert their utmost efforts in providing COE students with quality computer engineering education, close supervision in course work and academic progress, and innovative and practical methods in teaching and examinations. This necessitates offering a due balance among the theory, Engineering, and Science aspects of the discipline. The primary function of the department is quality teaching, research and Engineering applications. The department seeks to meet academic and professional standards at the national and international levels, and to provide a source of leadership and expertise for KFUPM, in particular and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, in general.

Number of COE Undergraduate and Graduate Students:

I concern that the number of COE BS, MS and Ph.D. students is going less gradually due to unforeseen circumstances, and expressed his utmost desire to increase it by promoting the COE/CSE Programs by organizing COE Days, publicizing them either through INTERNET or meeting with students. The total number of undergraduate students is 427 and PhD students 07.

Chairmanship is a Service Position:

I reiterate that the Chairmanship is a service position, and I will try my best to tackle professionally the academia as well as the administrative issues for the betterment of the students, faculty members, and for the growth of the department.

Departmental Management:

With regard to the departmental management, I emphasize that it is a group responsibility to run the department gracefully, and one person cannot go through. Team work is very essential.

Research etc.:

I would like to stress that every body should give priority to their research, students, environment, courses and development of COE laboratories.

I am planning to form research interest groups, distribute Research Assistants among groups for their active participation, and will invite key people in research to the

department. I also emphasize that all professorial rank faculty members in general, and assistant professors, in particular, to work on their research and increase their publications in the international/regional conferences and reputable journals so that they can be promoted to the higher academic rank. Also I encourage them to invite more key people in research as a Guest Speakers to deliver seminars in their area and meet with COE as well as CCSE faculty members for combined research projects of mutual interest.

I request you to reduce the individual workload, increase team work and spirit, emphasize practical home works, and maximum of two projects per class should be targeted to the core subject of the course except for courses that are project-oriented.

Students should be encouraged to take part in the extra-curricular activities, and emphasize them to participate in social activities (with students club), chess competition between faculty and students, beach gathering between faculty and students.

Students:

Faculty should give more practical doses, and encourage your students for team work, work ethics, and reduce absences. You should convince your students in these regards. Also give them less homework. In laboratories, team work should be emphasized because with this practice, the ability and confidence of students will be expanded with exchanging their ideas during the practical work.
