Q.3: Evaluate the double integral $\int_0^1 \int_{3y}^3 4e^{x^2} dx dy$. (Hint: Change order of integration)

Q.4: Use double integral to find the area enclosed by one loop of the graph of $r = \cos(2\theta)$.
