

Malaysian Law on Sale of Goods

This book was primarily intended to cater for needs of college students who studied commercial law at undergraduate level. It covers rules relating to English and Malaysian laws on sale of goods.

The salient features of this book are:

 - Conditions and other stipulations
 - Transfer of property
 - Passing of risk
 - The “Nemo dat quad non habet” rule
 - Performance of the sale contract
 - Lien and stoppage in transit
 - Suits for breach of the contract of sale
 - Exclusion of implied contractual terms and conditions
 - Application of the Contracts Act where the Sales Act is silent on a certain legal matter that concerns the sale of goods
- Dealing with English and Malaysian court decisions that illustrate or contrast the rules in question
- Explaining and presenting the provisions of the Malaysian Sale of Goods Act in a way that generally makes the book suitable for law practitioners, law students and traders or members of the community at large who might be interested in the law of sale of goods.
