COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course examines key issues in organizational theory and design. We will focus on how an organization's structure, its external environment, and its internal dynamics shape organizational action. Organizational theory is taught in other courses in the MBA curriculum, including MGT 580 (Organizational Behavior) and MGT 550 (Strategic Management). Although some overlaps are unavoidable (and perhaps desirable), this course stands out for its singular focus on matters of organizational structure (both formal and informal).

COURSE OBJECTIVES

After completing this course, students will have a better understanding of the following areas of organizational theory and design:

- The major perspectives and research paradigms of organization theory
- The role of formal and informal networks within organizations
- Organizational design, including different organizational structures and the circumstances under which each might be appropriate

- An organization's external environment and its effects on organizational structure and performance
- Organizational learning and methods to enhance knowledge sharing and idea development
- Innovation and strategic change, including better ways to implement change.

EXPECTED PERFORMANCE AND CLASS RULES:

- Students are expected to attend all lectures.
- The instructor will apply KFUPM attendance rules and class conduct. The instructor will take attendance when he sees that absence is high in any lecture.
- The grade of "DN" will be given to students with more than 6 unexcused absences.
- Official medical excuses will be accepted.
- The instructor will deduct 1 point from the attendance score for each unexcused absence and/or tardiness. The maximum number of unexcused absences is 6 lectures.
- Excuses should be presented to the instructor within a week from absence. However, excuses presented after a week from absence will not be accepted.
- Repeated lateness means absenteeism.
- No late student is allowed to attend the lecture after it begins (10 Minutes is OK for one time).

• PROJECT:

There will be a team project that must be submitted on time. **LATE** projects will not be accepted at all. The instructor will assign each four students to a project. The team members will be selected in the same order in the rooster sheet received from the REGISTRAR'S OFFICE. The project will be to construct A CONCEPTUAL PAPER that can be developed from sources available to students in the university library.

• CASES:

All students are required to work in teams to analyze the assigned business cases during the semester. Each team should submit a written report and present its case professionally. I will provide you with the cases, submission due date, and presentation due date. We will see the schedule of cases together in the classroom two weeks after the

ADD/DROP period. The team members will be selected the same way of the TEAM PROJECTS.

EXAMS:

Students will take two exams, one mid-term and a final. The exams will cover materials in textbook and lectures. The midterm will be an essay type of exam. The final will be a multiple choice and true/false.
