Lab Practice – Week#14

1. Using Macro commands within a VB program

- Docmd is a special object in MS Access which doesn't have any property defined. Only methods can be called.
- Docmd object is not a visual object like command buttons, labels or text boxes etc. Instead it is an internal object which is always available for calling different methods.
- The use of Docmd object is to call different MS Access operations (available in MACRO list) directly in the VBA code.

HANDS ON: USING MACRO COMMANDS INSIDE VBA CODE (DoCmd Object)

Open mdb file named 'Introduction to VBA.mdb'

On the Add Record and Close Form Button, use Docmd Object to call macro commands.

2. Using VBA CODE for Data Validation

Write a VBA Program to check for missing data (like email address) in a data entry form (Record Level Validation Check).

Use Form event, named BeforeUpdate to write your code.
