Query the table for all the countries that are marked as Islamic and promote these selected rows.

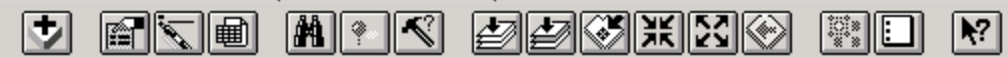
Create new fields for the attributes that were selected from the Research Center of the International Islamic University in the tribute tables.

Represent this data in an easy to comprehend maps and layout using the power of the GIS mapping systems.



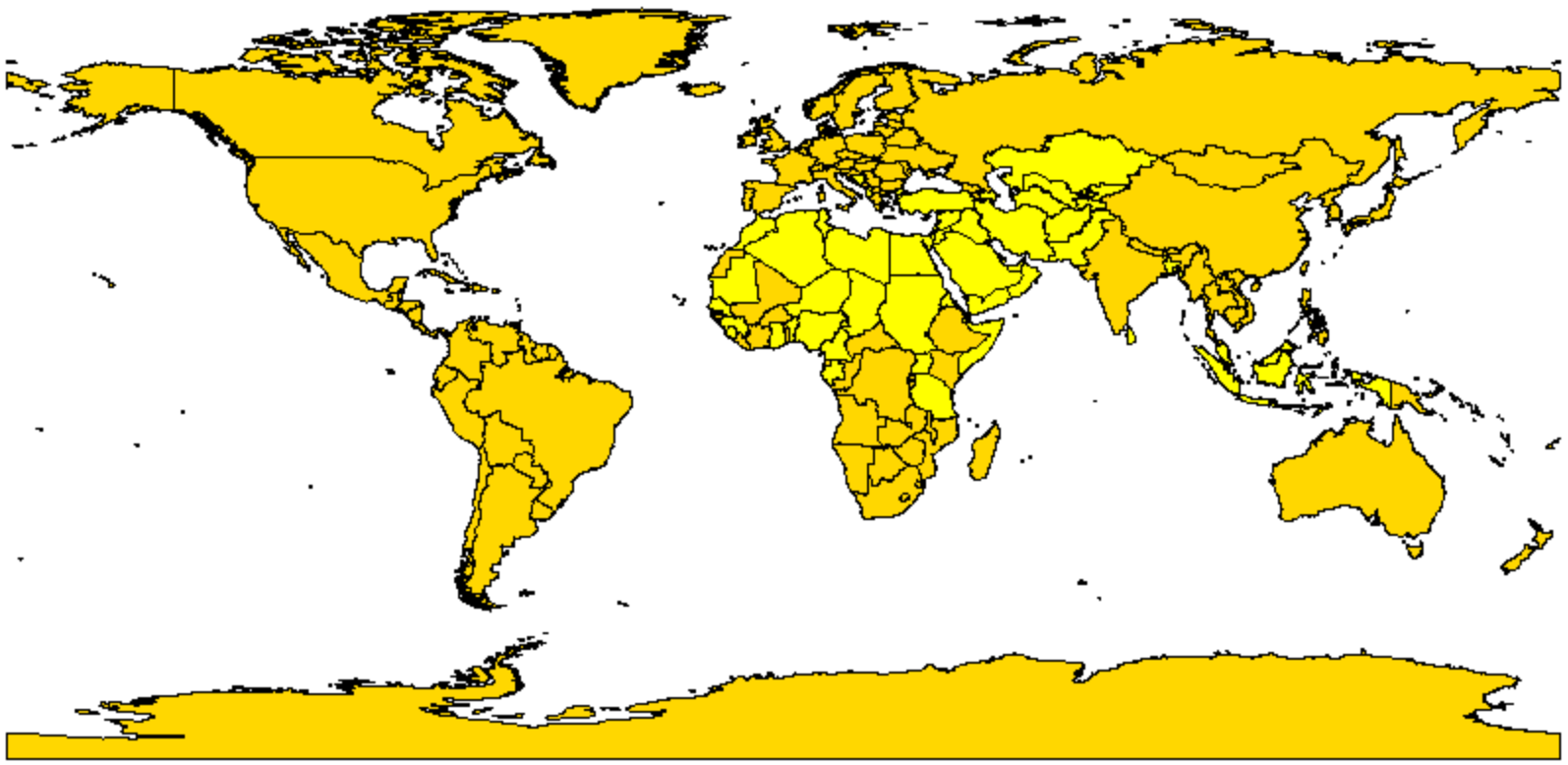
