Report

The report should be well structured. It should at least contain the following parts:

- 1. Cover Page
- 2. Abstract
- 3. Introduction
- 4. Body
- 5. Conclusion
- 6. References

The body and introduction might themselves be divided further if need be. The following points will be considered in evaluating the report

- 1. Coherence (readability and flow of the report)
- 2. Organization
- 3. Were essential equations derived?
- 4. Were the equations copied and pasted or were they actually typed.
- 5. Did the report contain additional insights?
- 6. Did the report contain MATLAB simulations?
- 7. Was the report submitted in time (in hard and soft copies)?

Presentation

The presentation should be 20 minutes long (15 minutes for the presentation and 5 minutes for Q&A). The presentation will be evaluated based on the following

- 1. Clarity
- 2. Presentably of Slides
- 3. Were the slides E-mailed on time?
- 4. Were the questions answered correctly?
- 5. Was the presentation finished on time?

There are a total of 12 presentations. They will be divided into a group of 6 presentations each (groups will be announced later on)
