Assignment #2

Objective: Learn basic information about the HTTP protocol and use a browser's developer tools to inspect HTTP headers.

Use Chrome Developer Tools to obtain snapshots showing the following HTTP Headers data.

- 1. Two snapshots showing *cookie* and *set_cookie* headers for *google.com.sa*; Name these snapshots as *cookie.png*, *set_cookie.png*. (Note: the *cookie* snapshot must correspond to *set-cookie* and have a later time.)
- 2. Two snapshots showing HTTP headers corresponding to two HTTP requests for fetching a specific image from your own course site (and both having the if-modified-since header), one snapshot where the image is gotten from the browser's cache; the other snapshot where the image comes directly the web server; Name these snapshots as cached.png, uncached.png.

Reference the four images (with appropriate titles) in an HTML file named *HW2.htm*, host it on your site and e-mail the corresponding URL to instructor.

Important Note: The textual info. in the four images must be clear and readable.

To get a screen-capture of the browser window, follow these steps:

Size Browser Window appropriately \rightarrow Alt+PrtSc (*image window is now saved to clipboard*) \rightarrow Start MS Paint (*Run mspaint*) and Paste \rightarrow File Menu/Save As & choose PNG format
