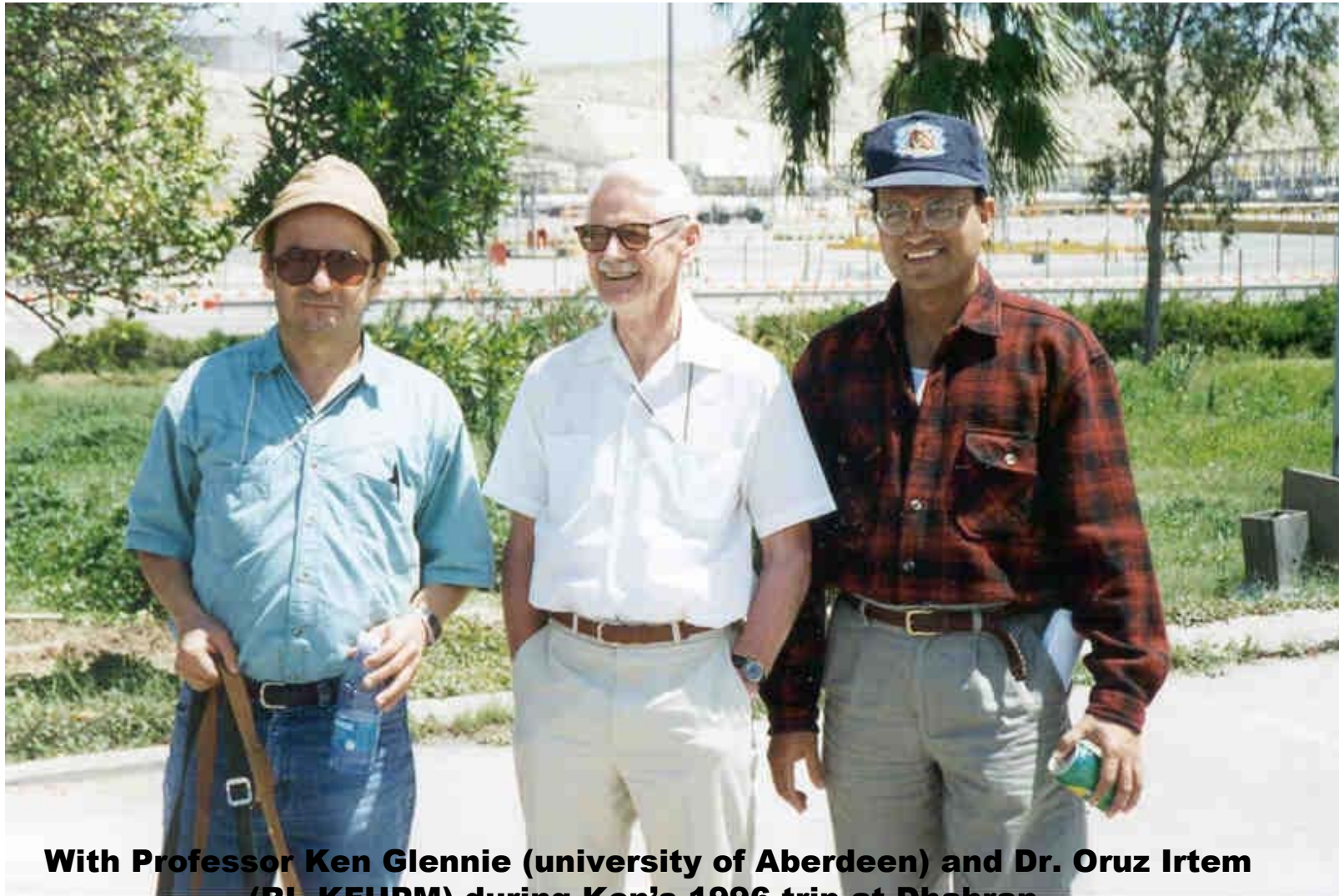

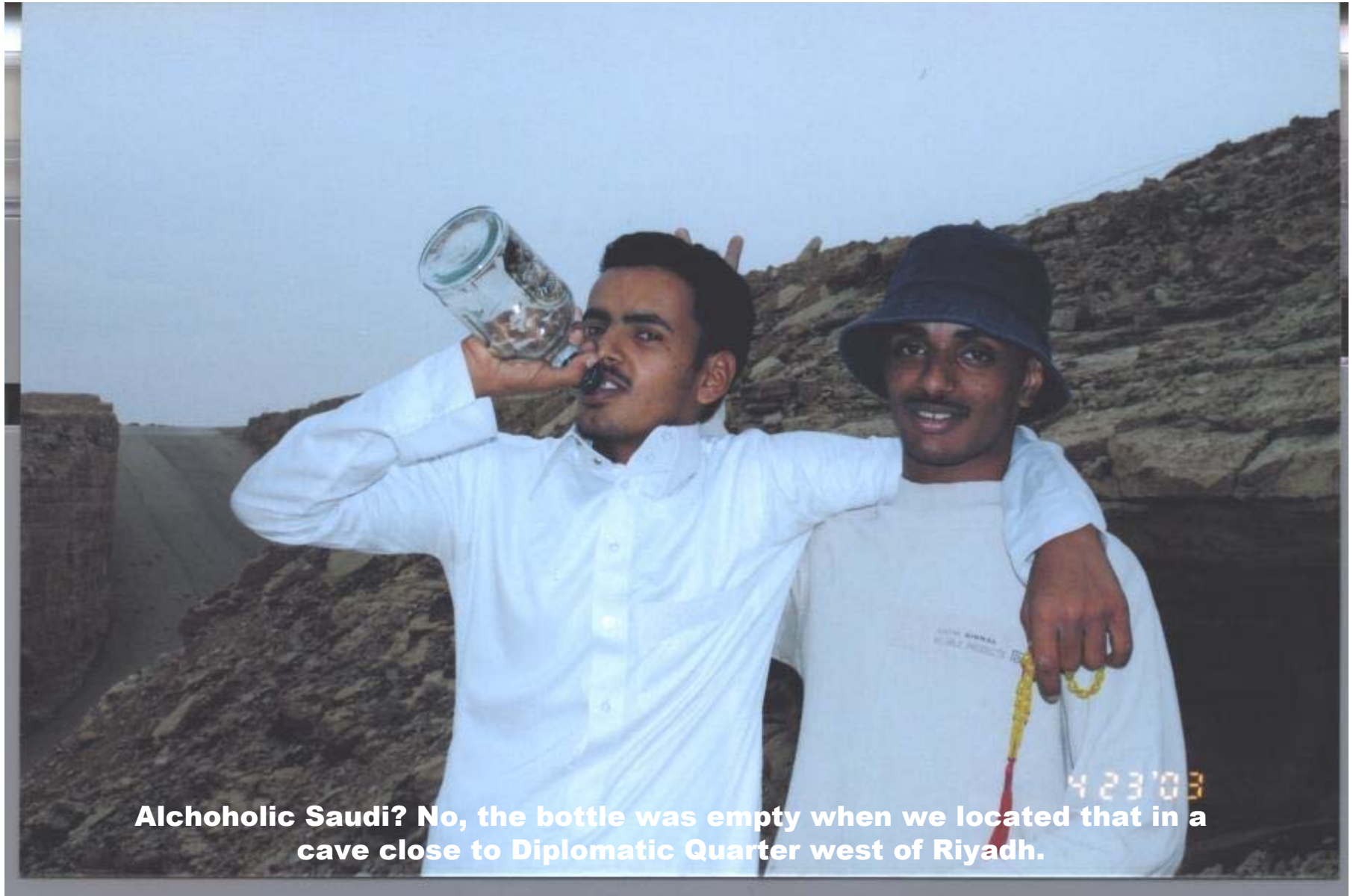

Alcoholic Saudi? No, the bottle was empty when we located that in a cave close to Diplomatic Quarter west of Riyadh.



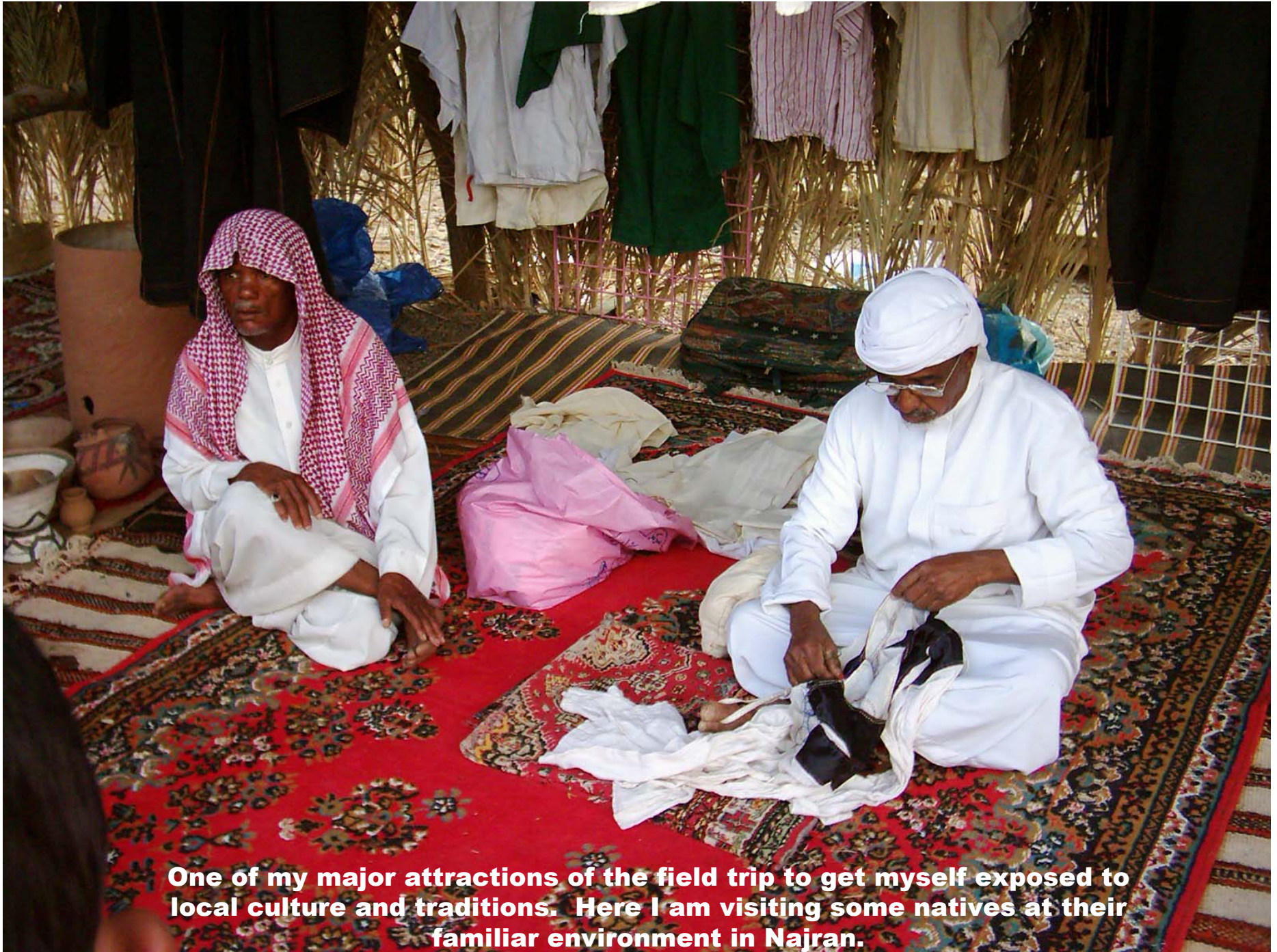
With my two boys, Shafayet (20) and Shanzyan (12) during a trip to Niagra falls in Summer of 2004.

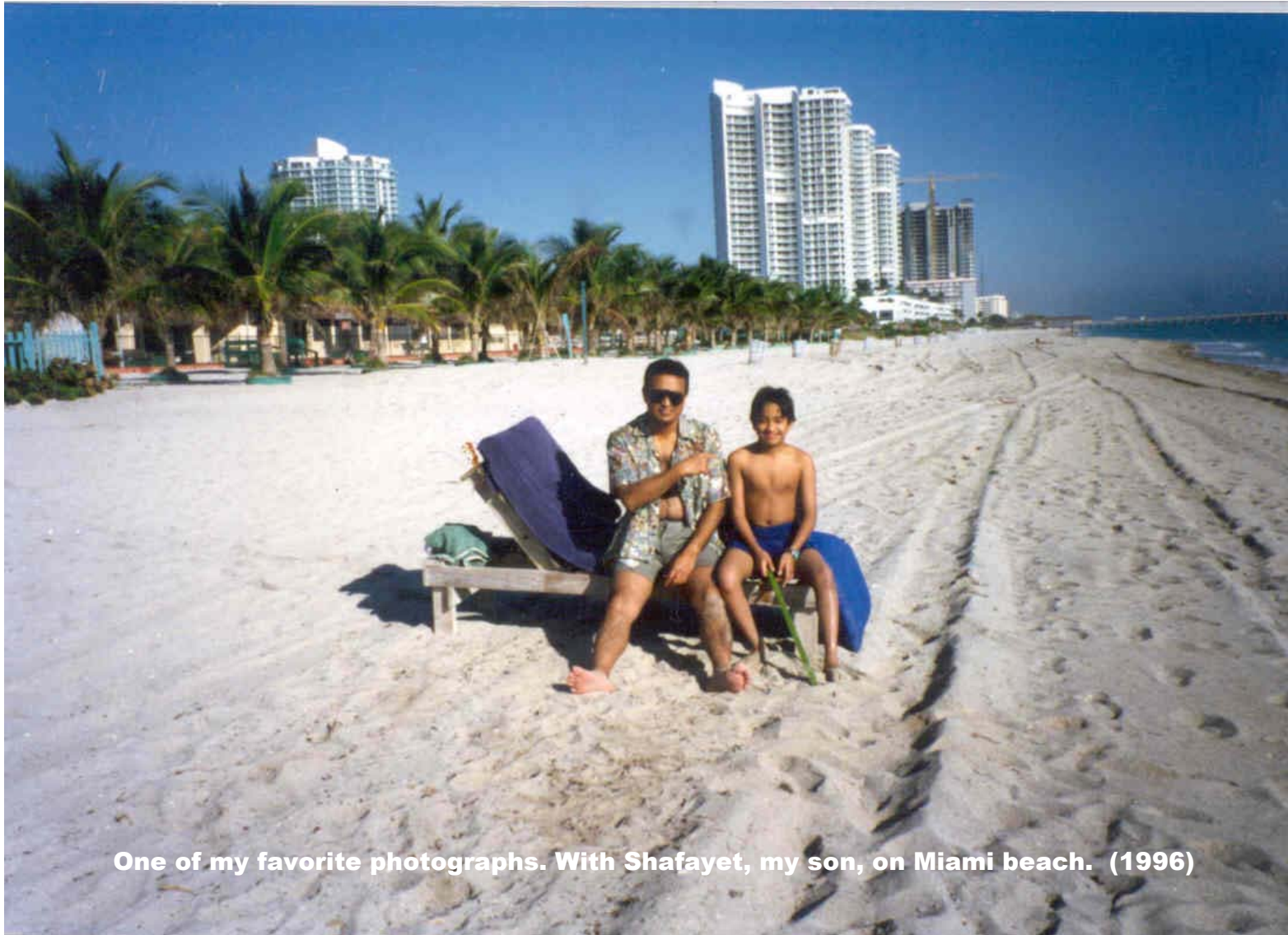
One of my major attractions of the field trip to get myself exposed to local culture and traditions. Here I am visiting some natives at their familiar environment in Najran.
