## **Course Description**

#### **Attendance Rules:**

The attendance rules for Preparatory English I (ENGL001) are as follows:

- 1. A **DN** grade will be awarded for more than 30 unexcused absences (10% of all classes).
- 2. 15 unexcused absences (5% of all classes on the course) will be permitted without penalty.
- 3. For each additional unexcused absence, 0.5% will be deducted from the total marks for the course.
- A DN grade will be awarded for more than 50 absences (1/6 of all classes) in total, whether excused or unexcused.
- **N.B.** a. Attendance will be recorded for all classes (four per day).
  - b. Teachers must record students' absence from their classes. Teachers cannot excuse any absence.
  - c. Excuses must be presented to the Preparatory Year Reception in Room 2002 within one week of returning to class.
  - d. Medical excuses will be accepted only from the KFUPM clinic. Certificates from other clinics or hospitals will not be accepted except for periods spent in hospital of more than one day.
  - e. **Check your attendance record**. If you find an error, ask your teacher to correct it. If he agrees with you, he will change the record. Any changes must be processed within three working days of posting the up-dated record. After that, the record will be accepted as correct.
