## **Abstract**

Ba was detd. in Ca-contg. matrixes by flame at.-absorption spectrophotometry after extn. by PEG 1540 from the matrix adjusted to  $1.8 \times 10$ -2 mol picric acid/dm3. Subsequent washing of the org. phase was unnecessary. For an initial concn. of  $2.0 \times 10$ -5 mol Ba/dm3, the mean recovery from 8 extns. was 99.50% with a std. deviation of  $0.1126 \times 10$ -6 mol/dm3.
