Question 1: If $A = \begin{bmatrix} 1 & 1 & 4 \\ 2 & 3 & 6 \\ -1 & -1 & 2 \end{bmatrix}$ such that $AB = BA = I_3$, then find the matrix B.

Answer:
$$B = A^{-1} = \begin{bmatrix} 2 & -1 & -1 \\ -\frac{5}{3} & 1 & \frac{1}{3} \\ \frac{1}{6} & 0 & \frac{1}{6} \end{bmatrix}$$

Question 2:

If A is 3×3 matrix such that |A| = -2 and A^{-1} exists, then find $|2A^{-1}|$.

Answer: $|2A^{-1}| = -4$

Question 3: Given the matrices $A = \begin{bmatrix} 1 & 3 \\ -2 & 2 \end{bmatrix}$ and $BA = \begin{bmatrix} -18 & 12 \\ -16 & 0 \end{bmatrix}$, then the element in the second row and first column of matrix B is

Answer: The element in the second row and first of B is -4

Question 4 Given the matrices $M^{-1} = \begin{bmatrix} 2 & 7 \\ 1 & 4 \end{bmatrix}$ and $N^{-1} = \begin{bmatrix} 1 & 2 \\ -2 & -3 \end{bmatrix}$, then find the sum of elements in 2^{nd} row of $(MN)^{-1}$

Answer: −33

Question5: The solution of the system $\begin{cases} 3x + 5y = -10 \\ -2x - 4y = 6 \end{cases}$ can be given by

A)
$$\begin{bmatrix} x \\ y \end{bmatrix} = \begin{bmatrix} 4 & 5 \\ -2 & -3 \end{bmatrix} \begin{bmatrix} -5 \\ 3 \end{bmatrix}$$

B)
$$\begin{bmatrix} x \\ y \end{bmatrix} = \begin{bmatrix} 4 & 5 \\ -2 & -3 \end{bmatrix} \begin{bmatrix} -10 \\ 6 \end{bmatrix}$$

C)
$$\begin{bmatrix} x \\ y \end{bmatrix} = \begin{bmatrix} -4 & -5 \\ 2 & 3 \end{bmatrix} \begin{bmatrix} -5 \\ 3 \end{bmatrix}$$

D)
$$\begin{bmatrix} x \\ y \end{bmatrix} = \begin{bmatrix} 5 & 4 \\ -2 & -3 \end{bmatrix} \begin{bmatrix} -10 \\ 6 \end{bmatrix}$$

E)
$$\begin{bmatrix} x \\ y \end{bmatrix} = \begin{bmatrix} -2 & -3 \\ 4 & 5 \end{bmatrix} \begin{bmatrix} -5 \\ 3 \end{bmatrix}$$
